

Map 5-a. Los Chortí: Most important municipios, 2001.

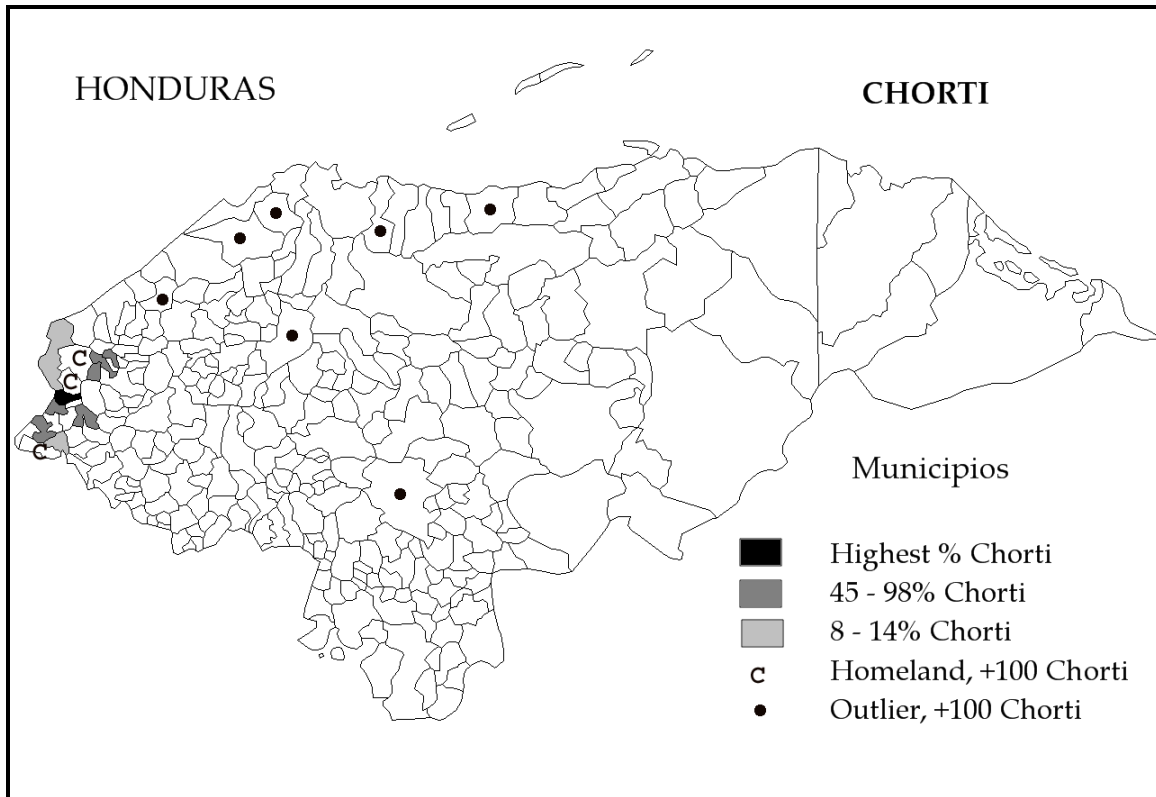

Perhaps the most striking aspect of Chortí population geography, according to the 2001 census, is the large number of settlements that claim to be all-Chortí. Fifty-six places are reported in the census as being occupied only by Chortí (table 5-b). Tables 5-c and 5-d present the list of Chortí 190 settlements, according to political division and size.
